

Communication Strategies

Course Overview:

Communication Strategies explains the communication characteristics associated with ASD. It also discusses the various strategies that support communication, including literal and visual strategies, and how all of these tools might help to build social relationships and reduce difficult behaviour.

Who Should Take the Course?

This module is designed for all individuals that wish to become respite supporters, or wish to learn the various strategies that can be used to communicate with individuals with ASD.

Course Objectives:

For individuals with ASD, communication, especially social communication, develops differently from people with typical development, or people with intellectual disabilities.
