Course Overview

The Employment Supports and Autism Training is a comprehensive, online training course for employment service providers to learn more about autism and, using best-practice strategies, will teach a range of support strategies for career professionals supporting Autistic people in an employment context.

By completing this course, you will enhance your knowledge of autism and your ability to accommodate both in the agency and at the workplace. You will gain an understanding and a greater confidence when providing individualized support for Autistic people and the neuro-diverse population looking to gain meaningful, long-term employment.

Module Overview

This module explores the topic of employment motivation of an Autistic person as they seek to attach to the labour market, along with strategies to support an Autistic individual when creating cover letters and resumes, applying to job postings and participating in job interviews.

Who Should Take the Course?

This course is designed for career practitioners, employment support practitioners, job developers, and case managers within the supported employment landscape across Canada.

Evaluation Process

At the end of each module, there are a series of post-assessment questions. Participants that do not achieve 70% can review the module content and try as many times as necessary to advance and complete the module.

Upon successfully completing each module, there is a printable certificate for your records.

Course Duration

This module is a self-paced lesson that should take approximately 60 minutes to complete. Participants may leave the module at any time and can resume at any time to complete.

Suggested duration of the modules range from 30 minutes to 90 minutes and total 10 hours for the entirety of the course. The duration will depend on the individual participant and their prior knowledge of the subject matter.

Course Objectives

This course is broken into 10 separate modules which each focus on a different topic related to autism and employment. This course provides a foundation of knowledge related to autism and effective strategies and interventions that you can use to support an Autistic job seeker or employee.
