The Over and Under Supporting training course will provide learners with an overview of language related to autism along with how to work in a person-directed way.

This course will provide an overview of over and under supporting along with self-managment strategy examples and how to help foster independence and self-advocacy in the individuals you work with.

This course is designed for career practitioners, employment support practitioners, job developers, and case managers within the supported employment landscape across Canada.
